This office has reviewed the Landscape Plan prepared by Dynamic Engineering, dated 4/28/2023, for the above reference application. The following items are submitted for your consideration.

- 1. Township Code Section 16-5.6.d.10 specifies the plant guarantee period to be 2 years after Township approval. Note #5 in the Planting Notes on sheet 8, Landscape Plan lists this requirement, however note #11 on the Planting Specifications on the bottom of the same page lists a 1-year guarantee period. This note shall be change to be compliant with the Township standards of a 2-year plant guarantee and to be consistent with note #5 in the Planting Notes.
- 2. Lambs Ear (Stachys byzantina) is a very aggressive invasive, non-native species. An alternate perennial should be specified.
- 3. The 'Oso Easy Double Pink' Rose is a ground cover shrub, not a perennial. Please list it in the appropriate category with the other ground cover plant.
- 4. The specified 'Winter Red' Winterberry Holly is an excellent choice for an ornamental deciduous shrub. However, it requires nearby male winterberry hollys to produce a reliable berry display. The most commonly recommended male winterberry holy that is compatible with this shrub is 'Southern Gentleman' Winterberry Holly. Please include 2 'Southern Gentleman' Winterberry Holly shrubs within the vacinity of the specified 'Winter Red' Winterberry holly shrubs.
- 5. The specified Emerald Green Arborvitae (Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald') is highly susceptible to deer browsing. An alternate evergreen tree should be specified. Suggested alternates are juniper, American holly and Colorado spruce.
- 6. Please include a dense evergreen tree/shrub buffer between Brecknell Way and the 3 space parking area adjacent to Brecknell Way to buffer the view of the parking area from the housing units and open space area on the opposite side of Brecknell Way.
- 7. Please include the appropriate site triangle for the Brecknell Way and Georgetown-Franklin Turnpike intersection. Township regulation do not allow any planting that growing over 18" tall in site triangle areas for traffic safety considerations.
