Electric Vehicles

Some interesting facts about EVs or Electric Vehicles:

- Swap and save. Replace a gaspowered car with an electric vehicle and lower your maintenance costs.
 The average cost to operate an EV is \$485 per year compared to \$1,117 per year for a gas-powered vehicle.
- Get a rebate. In 2023, up to \$4,000 is available from the state for buying or leasing an eligible vehicle. Federal tax credits between \$2,500 and \$7,500 are also available.
- Skip the tax. Zero-emission vehicles are exempt from New Jersey state sales tax.



- No emissions, no test. Battery electric vehicles are exempt from NJ emissions testing.
- **Move on up**. Plug-in EVs are eligible for HOV lanes on the NJ Turnpike as well as the Green Pass Discount for the NJ Turnpike and NJ Garden State Parkway.
- Range anxiety? Not in New Jersey! Explore NJ's map of public EV charging stations.
