4. **RESOLUTION HONORING RETIRING ASSISTANT TO THE TOWNSHIP ENGINEER GEORGE REMBOSKE**

WHEREAS, Civic dedication is a measure by which achievement is attained and thereafter a strength for every community; and

WHEREAS, After more than thirty-five years of dedicated service to the Township of Montgomery, George Remboske will be retiring from his position as Assistant to the Township Engineer; and

WHEREAS, During his tenure George has brought the utmost professionalism to his position while he made the business of the Township operate as efficiently as possible; and

WHEREAS, George oversaw the construction of countless development and capital projects during a time of rapid growth in Montgomery; and

WHEREAS, George is a Veteran of the U.S. Navy and has performed countless services, mostly unknown and unheralded as a member of the Township's Emergency Medical Services from 1997 to 2015; and

WHEREAS, During his years of faithful service he has earned the admiration and respect of co-workers, professionals and residents for his caring and patient response to their inquiries and concerns; and

WHEREAS, George's loyalty to Montgomery is evident by his outstanding work ethic and near perfect attendance, having amassed over 346 days of unused sick time.

WHEREAS, Resolution #17-6-146 adopted on June 15, 2017, authorized the award of a contract for the Montgomery Road Sidewalk project to A Team Concrete, Inc. in the amount of \$158,502.50; and

WHEREAS, The Township Engineer has requested the Committee's approval of a Change Order to reflect quantity adjustments and costs for the project; and

WHEREAS, Change Order #1 would allow for bid item quantity adjustments as outlined on said Change Order; and

WHEREAS, The work comprising Change Order #1 will result in a net decrease in the original contract amount by \$6,038.30 or -3.81%; and

WHEREAS, The Township Administrator has recommended approval of the Change Order; and

WHEREAS, A copy of the proposed Change Order is available in the Office of the Township Engineer.

WHEREAS, On or about July 27, 2016, pursuant to law Comcast of Central New Jersey II ("Comcast") filed with the Township of Montgomery an Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent to Construct, Connect, Operate and Maintain a Cable Television and Communications System in the Township; and

WHEREAS, Consistent with applicable procedure the Township held one (1) public hearing for purposes of consideration of Comcast's Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent on March 16, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Subsequent to said hearing, Comcast prepared for and submitted to the Township Administrator a proposed ordinance setting forth the terms and conditions of its sought-after Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent and since that time, Comcast and Township Administration have been negotiating the terms of the proposed ordinance renewing Municipal Consent to Comcast; and

WHEREAS, At this time the Township seeks express its intent to grant Municipal Consent to Comcast based on the proposed draft ordinance, a copy of which is on file in Clerk's Office, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.13 and 14:18-11.18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Township Committee of the Township of Montgomery in Somerset County, New Jersey, as follows:

1. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.13 and 14:18-11.18, the Township intends to grant Municipal Consent to Comcast based on its Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent filed on or about July 27, 2016 and draft ordinance on file with the Clerk's office.
2. A copy of the proposed draft ordinance shall be submitted to the Office of Cable Television for its review, comment and approval, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.18.

9. **RESOLUTION #18-6-140 - RESOLUTION PERMITTING ABATEMENT AND PLACING OF MUNICIPAL LIEN ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 31 CHARLESTON DRIVE FOR RECOVERY OF COSTS EXPENDED BY TOWNSHIP ABATING CERTAIN NUISANCES**

WHEREAS, The Health Officer was informed of a potential nuisance situation on an abandoned property known as Block 21008, Lot 5, and located at 31 Charleston Drive, Township of Montgomery, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that could affect the public health and welfare; and

WHEREAS, On May 22, 2018, the Registered Environmental Health Specialist mailed a letter to the owner responsible for the maintenance of the abandoned property located at 31 Charleston Drive, Township of Montgomery, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, regarding high grass nuisance conditions that existed on the property, as expressed in Exhibit A, on file in the Township's Health office; and

WHEREAS, On May 29, 2018, the Registered Environmental Health Specialist again contacted the owner responsible for the maintenance of the abandoned property located at 31 Charleston Drive, Township of Montgomery, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, regarding high grass nuisance conditions that existed on the property, by affixing said Notice of Violation, Exhibit B on file in the Township's Health office, to the front door of the property as permitted by the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The property owner or other responsible party failed to abate the nuisance conditions on the Subject Property following the expiration of the reasonable period provided to the property owner to abate the conditions; and

WHEREAS, The Health Officer has provided a detailed accounting of the costs to abate the existing nuisances to the Township Committee, a true and accurate copy of Exhibit C, on file in the Township's Health Office, and the Township Committee has reviewed the accounting provided, and agrees that the recommendation is reasonable, and in accordance with Section BH:1 et seq., of the Township Code; and

WHEREAS, The Township Committee agrees that the public should not bear the financial burden of abating the nuisance condition on the above-described private property, and that a municipal lien should be placed on the property pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.12g and any other applicable law; and

10. **RESOLUTION #18-6-141 - RESOLUTION DESIGNATING SPECIFIC TRACTS OF MUNICIPALLY-OWNED PARKS AND OPEN SPACES TO BE INCLUDED IN MONTGOMERY TOWNSHIP'S DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PURSUANT TO CHAPTER IX, SECTION 9 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTGOMERY (1984) FOR THE HUNTING SEASON BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER 2018 AND ENDING IN FEBRUARY 2019**

WHEREAS, as part of a comprehensive deer management plan and for the purpose of reducing the Township's white-tailed deer population, the Township Committee of the Township of Montgomery amended Chapter IX, "Parks and Recreation" of the Code of the Township of Montgomery (1984) ("Code") to allow limited hunting on the Township's parks and open spaces for the purpose of culling white-tailed deer; and

WHEREAS, Section 9-9 of the Code authorizes the Township Committee to designate annually by resolution which parks and open spaces will be made available for hunting through the Township's municipal deer management program and during which dates;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTGOMERY as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 9-9 of the Code of the Township of Montgomery (1984), the hunting of white-tailed deer will be allowed on the properties listed below within the timeframes established by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Fish and Wildlife ("State"). The anticipated hunting season will be from September 8, 2018 to February 16, 2019 subject to the restrictions and conditions set forth below. In the event any of the dates below are inconsistent with any dates established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Montgomery in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution.

A. Folusiak

Designation: Block 11001, Lots 55 and 56

Location: 125± acres on Spring Hill and Hollow Roads

Seasons/dates: This property shall be open to bow and firearm hunters during all regular deer hunting seasons established by the State of New Jersey for deer management zones 12 and 14 for 2018-2019, including fall bow, permit bow, winter bow, permit muzzleloader, six-day firearm, and permit shotgun. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are as follows, except that in the event any of the dates set forth below are inconsistent with any dates established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Montgomery in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:

<u>Fall bow:</u>	September 8 - October 26, 2018
<u>Permit bow:</u>	October 27 - December 24, 2018 December 26 - December 31, 2018
<u>Winter bow:</u>	January 1 - February 16, 2019
<u>Permit shotgun:</u>	December 3 - December 8, 2018 December 12 - December 14, 2018 January 5 - February 9, 2019
<u>Permit muzzle-loader:</u>	November 26 - November 27, 2018 December 3 - December 8, 2018 December 10 - December 11, 2018 December 15 - December 24, 2018 December 26 - December 31, 2018 January 1 - February 9, 2019
<u>Six-day firearm:</u>	December 3 - December 8, 2018

Permits: No more than ten (10) municipal deer management permits, and no more than two (2) Youth Hunting permits, shall be issued for this property.

Other restrictions: This property is subject to a farming lease agreement between the Township and a private farmer. Hunters shall not disrupt the farmer's operations, or damage, destroy or harm the farmer's crops, livestock or farming equipment.

Properly licensed persons hunting deer during the six-day firearm, muzzleloader rifle permit or shotgun permit deer seasons may kill coyote or fox if the coyote or fox is encountered before said person has taken the season bag limit of deer. Properly licensed persons are also authorized to take coyotes or foxes during the fall bow, permit bow, and winter bow seasons if the coyote or fox is encountered before said person has taken the season bag limit of deer. However, after the person has taken a daily bag limit of deer he or she must cease hunting immediately.

Properly licensed persons hunting deer who have a valid turkey season permit from the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife are authorized to take turkeys of either sex during the one week of the permit bow season that coincides with the fall turkey season if the turkey is encountered before said permittee has taken the season bag limit of deer. However, after the person has taken a daily bag limit of deer he or she must cease hunting immediately.

Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.

Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.

B. Opatut and Adjacent Land

Designation: Block 34001, Lots 35, 35.01, 35.06, 38.02, 43.02, 43.03, and an 18+ acre portion of Block 34023, Lot 72

Location: 165+ acres located off of County Route 518 and Pine Brae Drive

Seasons: This property shall be open to bow and firearm hunters during all regular deer hunting seasons established by the State of New Jersey for deer management zones 12 and 14 for 2018-2019, including fall bow, permit bow, winter bow, permit muzzleloader, six-day firearm, and permit shotgun. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are as follows, except that in the event any of the dates set forth below are inconsistent with any dates established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Montgomery in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:

<u>Fall bow:</u>	September 8 - October 26, 2018
<u>Permit bow:</u>	October 27 - December 24, 2018 December 26 - December 31, 2018
<u>Winter bow:</u>	January 1 - February 16, 2019
<u>Permit shotgun:</u>	December 3 - December 8, 2018 December 12 - December 14, 2018 January 5 - February 9, 2019
<u>Permit muzzle-loader:</u>	November 26 - November 27, 2018 December 3 - December 8, 2018 December 10 - December 11, 2018 December 15 - December 24, 2018 December 26 - December 31, 2018 January 1 - February 9, 2019
<u>Six-day firearm:</u>	December 3 - December 8, 2018

Permits: No more than eighteen (18) municipal deer management permits, and no more than two (2) Youth Hunting permits, shall be issued for this property.

Other restrictions: Anyone with a permit for this property may also hunt on Lot 72, provided that only bow hunting shall be permitted.

There shall be a "no firearm hunting" zone located on the easterly side of the northern portion of Lot 35 near the solar panel array located on the adjacent lot (Lot 38.03) as shown on the Deer Management Program Map. The boundaries of said "no firearm hunting" zone shall be clearly marked on the property. Only bow hunting shall be permitted in said zone and no loaded firearms shall be carried therein.

A portion of this property is subject to a farming lease agreement between the Township and a private farmer. Hunters shall not disrupt the farmer's operations, or damage, destroy or harm the farmer's crops, livestock or farming equipment.

Properly licensed persons hunting deer during the six-day firearm, muzzleloader rifle permit or shotgun permit deer seasons may kill coyote or fox if the coyote or fox is encountered before said person has taken the season bag limit of deer. Properly licensed persons are also authorized to take coyotes or foxes during the fall bow, permit bow, and winter bow seasons if the coyote or fox is encountered before said person has taken the season bag limit of deer. However, after the person has taken a daily bag limit of deer he or she must cease hunting immediately.

Properly licensed persons hunting deer who have a valid turkey season permit from the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife are authorized to take turkeys of either sex during the one week of the permit bow season that coincides with the fall turkey season if the turkey is encountered before said permittee has taken the season bag limit of deer. However, after the person has taken a daily bag limit of deer he or she must cease hunting immediately.

Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.

Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.

C. Dead Tree Run

Designation: Block 18026, Lot 27

Location: 69± acres located on Dead Tree Run Road

Seasons: This property shall be open only to bow hunters during the dates established for bow hunting by the State of New Jersey for deer management zones 12 and 14 for 2018-2019, including fall bow, permit bow, and winter bow. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are as follows, except that in the event any of the dates set forth below are inconsistent with any dates established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Montgomery in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:

<u>Fall bow:</u>	September 8 - October 26, 2018
<u>Permit bow:</u>	October 27 - December 24, 2018
	December 26 - December 31, 2018
<u>Winter bow:</u>	January 1 - February 16, 2019

Permits: No more than five (5) municipal deer management permits, and no more than two (2) Youth Hunting permits, shall be issued for this property.

Other Restrictions: This property is subject to a farming lease agreement between the Township and a private farmer. Hunters shall not disrupt the farmer's operations, or damage, destroy or harm the farmer's crops, livestock or farming equipment.

Properly licensed persons hunting deer are authorized to take coyotes or foxes during the fall bow, permit bow, and winter bow seasons if the coyote or fox is encountered before said person has taken the season bag limit of deer. However, after the person has taken a daily bag limit of deer he or she must cease hunting immediately.

Properly licensed persons hunting deer who have a valid turkey season permit from the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife are authorized to take turkeys of either sex during the one week of the permit bow season that coincides with the fall turkey season if the turkey is encountered before said permittee has taken the season bag limit of deer.
