"No soil shall be removed from or be imported to any site in excess of twenty (20) cubic yards per year without the prior approval of the Planning Board."

Additionally, land disturbance greater than 1500 square feet and in specific cases less than 1500 square feet require a "Soil Disturbance and Soil Removal Permit" per Chapter XIV of the Code of Montgomery.

Requirements

Importing Soil to Montgomery Township

- Letter of certification stating that the soil is **CLEAN** and it **meets Residential Direct Contact Soil Remediation Standards**.

Importing/Exporting soil within Montgomery Township from Lot to Lot

- Letter of certification stating that the soil is **CLEAN** and it **meets Residential Direct Contact Soil Remediation Standards**.

Exporting Soil from Montgomery Township

- Township Engineer (outside of Montgomery Township) advising in writing fill **will not be detrimental** to Township receiving fill.

Importing/Exporting Soil within Montgomery Township

- Approved major subdivisions do not require a Soil Disturbance Permit if under a Somerset-Union Soil Conservation District permit. **All** other locations require a separate Soil Disturbance Permit Application to be submitted to this Department.

The following conditions shall be adhered to for all of above:

- a. A clearly designated route for the trucks coming to and leaving the site shall be submitted and is subject to the approval of the Township Engineer or his authorized representative.
- b. No trucks shall arrive at or leave the site with material prior to 8:00 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m.
- c. No trucks shall operate on legal holidays, or Sundays.
- d. A videotape of the existing condition of Township-owned paved cartways along the route may be required to be filed with the Township Engineer, or authorized representative, prior to the hauling of fill material on Township roads.
- e. Any damage to said cartway deemed by the Township Engineer, or authorized representative, to be a direct cause of said hauling operation shall be corrected immediately to the satisfaction of the Township Engineer who shall require repairs to be made in accordance with the Township Ordinances.
- f. The hauler is responsible for all "dirt" accidentally dropped on any roads along the hauling route within Montgomery Township. Roads shall be cleaned up immediately upon notice from the Engineering Department. Failure to follow this condition will result in the Township Engineer's requirement for prewashing of all excess soils from the tires and/or truck undercarriage prior to the entrance onto and use of Township roads.

- g. Tracking pad, if deemed necessary, by the Engineer shall be installed upon notice. Failure to do so shall result in a "Stop Work Order". All tracking pads shall be 100' long x 20' wide and no less than 6" thick with crushed stone.
- h. It is agreed upon if any of the above conditions is not adhered to and upon notification by Montgomery Township Engineer, or authorized agent, trucking of fill shall be immediately terminated.
- i. Any Montgomery Township site other than an approved subdivision under Somerset-Union Soil Conservation District jurisdiction shall require a separate permit for soil disturbance in accordance with Chapter XIV of the Code of Montgomery.
- j. Certain major subdivisions may be limited regarding import/export of soil by Planning/Zoning Board resolution and/or Governing Body resolution and/or developers agreement.
