Earlier this week, one of our residents passed away due to complications related to COVID-19. Out of respect for the privacy of this individual and the family, we cannot share specific information about the circumstances.

It is always difficult when we lose a member of our community, but particularly so during this time of self-isolation when we cannot join together to share both our grief and memories. Our condolences and prayers go out to the family and loved ones of the individual who passed away.

In the spirit of open communication, we have shared this information directly with Stonebridge residents, staff and family members, while taking care to maintain the privacy of the resident and family.

We are diligent in reporting all cases to the Montgomery Township Health Department and are working closely with local, state and federal officials to follow the guidelines and protocols required to protect our residents and staff members. While we still have confirmed and suspected cases among our staff and residents, we are now seeing success stories as members of both groups are recovering and, in the case of employees, returning to work.

The well-being of our all residents and staff remains our top priority. Our entire team continues to work tirelessly, taking extensive measures to protect the health and safety of all community members from COVID-19.
